CONTRACT AGREEMENT

PROCUREMENT OF SECURITY SERVICES FOR CY 2022 OF THE NATIONAL DEFENSE COLLEGE OF THE PHILIPPINES NDCP-ITB-010-21

WHEREAS, the Entity invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, particularly Procurement of Security Services for CY 2022 of the National Defense College of the Philippines, and has accepted a Bid by the Supplier for the supply of those goods and services in the sum of THREE MILLION THREE HUNDRED SIXTY SEVEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIX PESOS AND FIFTY SIX CENTAVOS ONLY (PhP3,367,906.56) (hereinafter called "the Contract Price").

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
- 2. The following documents as required by the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz.:
 - a. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. Schedule of Requirement
 - ii. Technical Specifications;
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
 - iv. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any
 - b. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;

Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;

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- c. Performance Security;
- d. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and
- e. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.
- 3. In consideration for the sum of THREE MILLION THREE HUNDRED SIXTY SEVEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIX PESOS AND FIFTY SIX CENTAVOS ONLY (PhP3,367,906.56) or such other sums as may be ascertained, the Supplier agrees to execute and complete the Works and remedy any defects therein in accordance with Supplier's Bid.
- 4. The Entity agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.
- 5. The Supplier shall faithfully comply with all applicable labor and social welfare laws, rules, and regulations and Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) orders, including those related to rights and benefits of its employees in respect of (i) safe and healthful working conditions; (ii) labor standards such as service incentive leave, rest days, overtime pay, 13th month pay, and separation pay; (iii) retirement benefits; (iv) contributions and remittances to the Social Security System (SSS), Philhealth, Employees Compensation Commission (ECC), Home Development Mutual Fund (Pag-Ibig), and other welfare benefits; (v) self-organization, collective bargaining, and peaceful concerted action; and (vi) security of tenure.
- 6. The Supplier shall make timely payment of mandated employee benefits and remittance of premiums, such as but not limited to SSS, Philhealth, ECC, Paglbig, among others. Pursuant to this, the Supplier shall submit to the Entity, within seven (7) calendar days, proofs of payment for the amount paid to the security guards such as the mandated daily wage, and overtime and premium pay, if any. The Supplier shall likewise submit to the Entity, within seven (7) calendar days, proofs of payment for the amount paid to the government in favor of the security guards such as Retirement Benefit (R. A. No. 7641), SSS premium, Philhealth contribution, State Insurance Fund, and Pag-Ibig Fund.
- 7. Failure of the Supplier to comply with any labor standard law or regulation or to submit proof of compliance of amount paid to the security guards or amount paid to the government in favor of the security guards within seven (7) calendar

days shall be considered by the Entity as a substantial breach of the Agreement. The Entity reserves the right to terminate this Agreement.

8. The failure of the Entity to demand compliance with any of the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall not be considered a waiver by the Entity of the enforcement of the Agreement nor shall it relieve the Supplier of any obligation in the Agreement. Any waiver or failure to exercise a right or remedy by the Entity shall not affect the right of the Entity at a later time to require performance or compliance. The waiver or failure to exercise a right or remedy by the Entity shall not be construed as a continuing waiver or failure to exercise.
